

ANNEX 1-A

ELIMINATION OF IMPORT CUSTOMS DUTIES

Introductory notes

1. The tariff elimination schedules in this Annex contain the following four columns:

- (a) **“HS 2017”**: the code used in the nomenclature of the Harmonized System 2017;
- (b) **“Description”**: description of the product falling under the heading;
- (c) **“Base Rate”**: the basic import customs duty rate from which the tariff elimination program starts; and
- (d) **“Category”**: the category under which the product concerned falls for the purposes of tariff elimination.

2. Interim staged rates shall be rounded at least to the nearest tenth of a percentage point or, if the rate of duty is expressed in monetary units, at least to the nearest tenth of one Chinese Yuan in the case of China and the nearest Chilean peso in the case of Chile.

Section 1

Import Customs Duties on Imports Originating in China

1. The categories which are applicable to imports into Chile from China are the following:
 - (a) **“Year 1”**: import customs duties shall be eliminated entirely and such goods shall be duty-free on the date this Protocol enters into force; and
 - (b) **“EXCL”**: these products are not subject to tariff elimination.
2. Originating goods not included in the Schedule of Chile are duty free.

Schedule of Chile

Section 2

Import Customs Duties on Imports Originating in Chile

1. The categories which are applicable to imports into China from Chile are the following:
 - (a) **“Year 3”**: import customs duties shall be removed in three equal annual stages beginning on the date this Protocol enters into force, and such goods shall be duty-free, effective from January 1st of year three; and
 - (b) **“EXCL”**: these products are not subject to tariff elimination.
2. Originating goods not included in the Schedule of China are duty free.
