## ANNEX II-A PRODUCT SPECIFIC RULES OF ORIGIN

## **Section A: Introductory Notes**

- 1. A change in tariff classification requirement under this Annex requires that each of the non-originating materials used in the production of the good undergoes a change of tariff classification as a result of production in the territory of one or both Parties.
- 2. For the purposes of the product specific rules set out in this Annex:
- (a) "CC" denotes a change to the chapter, heading or subheading from any other chapter. This indicates that all non-originating materials used in the production of the good have undergone a change in tariff classification at the two-digit level (i.e. a change in chapter) of the Harmonized System;
- (b) "CTH" denotes a change to the chapter, heading or subheading from any other heading. This indicates that all non-originating materials used in the production of the good have undergone a change in tariff classification at the four-digit level (i.e. a change in heading) of the Harmonized System;
- (c) "RVC%" denotes the minimum requirement of regional value content as calculated under Article 3.4 (Regional Value Content) of Chapter 3 (Rules of Origin); and
- (d) "**WO**" indicates that the good is wholly obtained or produced in a Party as defined in Article 3.3 (Goods Wholly Obtained or Produced) of Chapter 3 (Rules of Origin).
- 3. For goods classifiable under provisions for "waste" and "scrap" and which are not described by name, the origin criteria shall be WO.
- 4. This Annex is formulated on the basis of the Harmonised System as updated as Version2017.
